- Physician has DO license
- PA has Osteopathic license starting with OS

STATE PAPERWORK REQUIREMENTS

- **Application for Registration as a Supervising Physician** must be completed when a new PA is hired or a primary supervising physician leaves and you need to assign another primary supervising physician..
 - Need for One primary supervising physician and List all substitute physicians on application
 - Answers to the application questions – written agreement
 - Templates available on the Medical Affairs intranet site through the managers tool kit under Allied Professional Staffing <http://medaffairs.slhn.org> .
 - Signature by the Primary Physician, all substitute physicians and PA
 - You may have allopathic substitute physicians on the osteopathic application
 - Check for \$95
 - Copy x 3 and maintain one for files at the practice site, one copy for enrollment and one copy for Medical Affairs

Application must be approved by the State Board of Osteopathic Medicine before PA begins working

- **Written Agreement Change Form** must be completed if:
This form is to be completed when reporting a change to an existing, approved Osteopathic physician assistant supervisor written agreement.
 - You add or delete a substitute supervising physician
 - Add or delete a physician assistant
 - Dissolve a written agreement
 - Make changes in Protocol, including changing job duties of the PA
 - Changing PA prescribing or dispensing privileges
 - Changing or Adding Practice Address
